Educational Programming: The Writer-in-Residence will provide an educational program on a quarterly basis for a period of two years. Program content, dates and times will be agreed to by the Writer-in-Residence and the Foundation's chairman. The Writer-in-Residence will also mentor the winner of our Hemingway Foundation Scholarship on a quarterly basis. The scholarship is awarded to an incoming senior at Oak Park River Forest High School each year. The Writer-in-Residence and student will choose a date for their discussion at which time they will also agree on a subject for the student's writing assignment.
