Educational Programming: The Writer-in-Residence will provide an educational program on a quarterly basis for a period of one year. Program content, dates and times will be agreed to by the writer-in-residence and the Foundation's president.

Building Access and Use: Access to the Birthplace Home will be provided during regular business hours, weekdays 9:00 am - 5:00 pm and only to the designated Writer-in-Residence space. The work done in the Home is granted permission only for the purpose listed in the agreement. We ask that the Writer set up an appointment with the Executive Director to view the space prior to occupancy.

Liability:

The Writer-in-Residence will assume financial responsibility for any damage to or loss of The Ernest Hemingway Foundation of Oak Park property occurring as a result of or during the use of the property and for any personal injury that may occur during or as a result of such use.
